



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS AND GUESTS

All members and guests of Weston Colville Cricket Club will:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of cricket.
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, race, ethnic origin, religious belief, gender, disability, nationality, colour, sexual preference or political belief.
- Not condone or allow to go unchallenged any form of discrimination.
- Display high standards of behaviour.
- Promote positive aspects of cricket.
- Actively discourage unfair play, rule violation and arguing with match officials.
- Recognise good performance, not just match results.

In addition to the above, those actively involved with children will:

- Place the well-being of children above performance.
- Ensure that activities are appropriate to the age, maturity, experience and ability of the individual.
- Respect children's opinions when making decisions regarding their participation in cricket.
- Follow ECB guidelines as set out in Safe Hands – Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children.
- Report any concerns regarding child welfare using the guidelines published by the club.
- NOT smoke, drink or use banned substances or provide children with alcohol.
